3	Payment in full is due the day of auction by cash, check, Visa or MasterCard. A 3% Buyer's Premium Clerk Fee applies; however it is waived if payment is cash or check.
4	Everything, <u>including vehicles</u> , is sold "AS-IS WHERE-IS", with no expressed or implied warranty whatsoever by Kramer & Kramer, Inc. and the City of Dayton, Ohio. The Seller and Auctioneer assume no responsibility as to condition, whatsoever. Inspect all items to your own satisfaction, as all sales are final. No exceptions.
5	Removal of ALL items becomes the responsibility of the BUYER. Any items purchased, and not removed will be removed at Buyer's Expense.

Loading and Removal of Items Purchased:

6	Nothing is to be removed until full payment and settlement is made to the Auction Firm.

9	Tues, Sept 23 Gates Open at 9:00 AM / Gates Close at 12:00 Noon
10	Wed., Sept 24 Gates Open at 9:00 AM / Gates Close at 12:00 Noon
11	Receipts are necessary to remove items out of yards. Security will be present and items being removed may be audited to your cashier's statement. Keep it with you at all times. At the time of sale, a buyer number will be written on the item for buyer security. Theft of any kind will not be tolerated and violators will be prosecuted.
12	Auction staff members will monitor buyers during loading out, but are not to perform the loading of items purchased. Buyers must wait their turn and abide by the direction of Auction Staff members.
13	Forklifts are to be operated by Dayton City Employees only. Under no circumstance is a buyer or Kramer Auction Staff member to operate a forklift. The City of Dayton and Kramer & Kramer, Inc. and their employees are not liable for any damage to merchandise while assisting loading & furthermore, reserve the right to refuse to load anything in a manner they determine to be unsafe.
14	Entrance of vehicles to the Yards is from the East gate. Driver's must present a valid photo ID.
15	Safety is of the utmost concern and movement of large rigs and or trailers will only be permitted in areas where the auction is finalized. Nothing shall be removed until the auction staff, or city of Dayton employees, clears an area for removal.
16	Vehicles are released by rows. Once an entire row is sold, under the direction of the Auction staff, and after receiving their title and keys, buyers may remove their vehicle.

Titled Vehicles

Cash & Credit Card:	Title Available on auction day
Check	Title will be mailed <u>AFTER 10 Business days</u>, allowing check to clear. Buyer to fill out envelope for mailing of title.
PROCEDURES:	After payment is made, Buyer will take their Kramer & Kramer Paid receipt Statement AND the " <u>Title Information Sheet</u> " to the Title Check out area to claim their title. Buyers may only remove their vehicle, once the auction staff clears the row of vehicles their vehicle is located in, and not before.
Vehicle Keys:	Once payment and titles are finalized, the keys will be given to the buyer at the title check out area.
